A dog with a healthy digestive tract, however, has a pH level in the stomach that is set up to digest protein, fat and bone, and kill any pathogenic bacteria on the raw meat.

To get your pet's gut ready to handle raw diets you need to prepare the digestive environment first and set them up for success. Only then will they handle their natural diet with ease.
